

Welcome to the application process for the 2025 Northwest Lions Leadership Institute. Congratulations on taking the first step in honing your leadership skills! The time you spend at the Institute will not only serve you well in Lions, but in your worksite and your other relationships as well.

Institute Details

When: May 1-4, 2025

Classes start at 2:00 pm May 1;

Where: Ross Point camp and Conference Center 820 S. Ross Point Rd. Post Falls, Idaho 83854

Cost: \$350 US or \$375 CAN (a deposit is required to be submitted with the application); This covers:

- Three nights lodging at Ross Point Camp is included at no additional charge.
- Dinner on May 1; Breakfast, lunch, and dinner, May 2-3; Breakfast on May 4.
- All training materials.

Applicants from Clubs in MD19 can apply for a special fee waiver, which can reduce the cost of the Institute by \$200.

The application process includes several steps which **all** must be complete and submitted by April 1, 2025.

- 1. Application data
- 2. Candidates Lions history, community service, and goals for attending the Institute
- 3. Lions Reference Contact Information
- 4. Deposit \$150 US or \$175 Canadian
- 5. Fee reduction request available for Lion members of Multiple District 19 only

Complete your application:

• <u>Application form</u> which includes application data, the candidate's Lions history, and fee reduction request as well as contact information for your Lions personal reference must be recieved by May 1, 2024

*Note that you can sign this form electronically. Simply click on the signature field and follow the prompts to create a new digital ID (if you have not created one already). Once you have completed the form, be sure to save it to your computer and send it as an attachment to the Institute Registrar. *Once you have submitted your application, it cannot be updated and re-submitted.*

The application and deposit need to be sent to the Institute Registrar. Upon receipt of all pieces of the application you will be notified of your acceptance into the Institute.

Your request for this fee reduction will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis. All pieces of your application must be received by the registrar by the registration due date for the fee reduction to be granted.
